Constitution Day & National Day, 2024

Embassy of Nepal in Pretoria celebrated the 10th Constitution Day and National Day of Nepal with various programs in Pretoria, South Africa from 18 to 21 September 2024. A reception was hosted at the Ambassador's residence on Saturday, 21 September 2024.

Charge' d'Affaire's a.i. Mr. Ramesh Kumar Charmakar extended warm greetings and best wishes to all guests on this very happy celebration of the National Day of Nepal. As this celebration commemorates the 10th anniversary of the promulgation of the Constitution of Nepal, Mr. Charmakar highlighted some salient features of the Constitution. He further added a few words on so happily subsisting Nepal-South Africa bilateral ties marked by friendship, cooperation, mutual understanding and goodwill ever since the establishment of diplomatic relations in 1994. The Declaration of Intent of Cooperation agreed by the two countries have further added the momentum to expand as well as deepen our diversified bilateral cooperations.

Many foreign guests including the representative from the Department of International Relations and Cooperation of South Africa and members of diplomatic corps from the accredited countries, business people, representatives from Nepali communities as well as students joined the celebration and exchanged the greetings.
